

Naik, Shri Jaykrishna Putu, M.G. (Shiroda): b. at Agastipur, Ponda on September 18th, 1932; m. to Prema S. Pedenekar; ed. Hindi-Parichaya, Portuguese-Segundo-Grau; upto matric; Agriculturist; knows Hindi, Marathi, Konkani, Portuguese and English; Freedom fighter; four and half years in imprisonment at Aguada, Central jail for the caused of liberation, arrested on 17th February, 1955 by the Portuguese Government at Shiroda for actively working for Goa National Congress; after released from jail remained underground in the guise of the teacher; was active worker of Indian National Congress, after liberation represented Congress Session held at Durgapur, Jaipur, Gandhinagar (Ahmedabad); joint Marashtrawadi Gomantak Party around 1970; worked as Secretary of Adarsh V.K.S. Society, Shiroda, Chairman All Goa Dairy Federation; President, Shiroda English High School; Vice-President, Gomantak Primary School Teachers Union(Prathamik Shikshak Sangh); Secretary, Dayanand Foundation; Chairman, Goa Co-operative Marketing and Supply Federation; Member, Jails Committee, Goa; Treasure, Kamalbai Hede High School; Shiroda; Member, All India Consumers Council; Member, Rural Programme Committee of All India Radio, Goa; Member, Third Legislative Assembly i.e. 1972-77; Member, Fourth Legislative Assembly from June, 1977, Member on Committee on Petitions 1972-73, 1973-74, 1974-75, 1975-76 and 1977-78; Member, Public Accounts Committee 1972-73, 1973-74, 1974-75, 1975-76, 1976-77 and 1977-78; Member, Library Committee, 1973-74.
